Whatever the innermost part of a person resists is also not according to the will of God, just as the will to serve God determines them to think and act. Unconscionable people, however, also receive the transmissions of the bad forces, and they then let their will become active by performing bad deeds. Yet they are not hindered from it. If they give no heed to the inner voice, then every attempt of the good beings is in vain, their influence is minimal, and consequently they withdraw from people until they seek God again of their own impulse and He thus lets Himself be found by them. If the striving for perfection in man is great, he also recognizes whether the inner voice warns him correctly, and he also feels what he should reject, for to the striving man God gives the right knowledge, and he need only heed the innermost voice within him, for he will be correctly guided now and for all time....
